WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

- Personal information from parents and children making applications for grants
- Donors of funds
- Purchases of equipment
- Marketing contacts
- Health professionals

This can include names, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, social media accounts, and details of diagnoses.

HOW DO WE USE PERSONAL INFORMATION?

- To determine grant allocation
- Account set up and administration
- Delivering marketing and events communication
- Carrying out polls and surveys
- Internal research and development purposes
- Legal obligations (eg prevention of fraud)
- Meeting internal audit requirements

We use consent and legitimate interest as the legal basis or processing your personal data. We do not share personal data.

HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

We keep data for 6 years, excepting applications for grants, which are stored in perpetuity subject to an annual review.
